both n't and not are correct.

1. Suzy cooks dinner every night.  
(NEG) Suzy **doesn't cook** dinner every night.
2. Mike cleans the kitchen.  
(NEG) Mike **doesn't clean** the kitchen.
3. Mike and Suzy do their laundry on weekends.  
(NEG) Mike and Suzy **don't do** their laundry on weekends..
4. The couple planned their wedding carefully.  
(NEG) The couple **didn't plan** their wedding carefully.
5. Now they have enough money to buy a small house.  
(NEG) Now they **don't have** enough money to buy a small house.

In #3, the X-Word AND the main verb are both "do."

In #5, "have" is the main verb, not an X-Word.

(Y/N) **Does** Suzy **cook** dinner every night?
2. Mike cleans the kitchen.  
(Y/N) **Does** Mike **clean** the kitchen?

(Y/N) **Do** Mike and Suzy **do** their laundry on weekends?
4. The couple planned their wedding carefully.  
(Y/N) **Did** the couple **plan** their wedding carefully?
5. Now they have enough money to buy a small house.

 [The children] don't took their medicine.

                      S                    X mw Vb  
 [The children] didn't take their medicine.

                      S                    X mw Vb  
 [The children] don't take their medicine.

★ The X-Word gives the verb tense, not the main verb.

5                    S                    X mw VxS  
 [The restaurant] don't serves pasta.

                      S                    X mw Vb  
 [The restaurant] doesn't serve pasta.

★ A singular subject in present time needs an X-Word or verb with an "s" (has, does, is, was) The restaurant DOES

★ The "s" on the verb travels with the X-Word.

6                    S                    X mw DTN  
 [The police car] didn't gone.

                      S                    X mw Vb  
 [The police car] didn't go.

★ Always use Vb after the X-Words Do Does or Did

                      S                    X mw DTN  
 [The police car] hadn't gone.

★ With DTN, use have, has, had as the X-Word.

Also correct:

                      S                    X mw DTN  
 [The police car] hasn't gone.

S X mw  
Suzy and Sumin didn't to school together.

S X mw Vb  
Suzy and Sumin didn't go to school together.

★ Missing main verb

S X V/XD  
We were did our work.

S V/XD  
We did our work.

DID is the main verb. You don't need an X/Word.

★ Never use V/XO, V/XS or V/XD after an X-Word

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9

S V/XD  
Jin no went to school.

S X Vb  
Jin didn't go to school.

★ To make a negative, add not or n't after an X-Word.

★ The X-Word gives the verb tense, not the main verb.

In English, "no" is used as a quantifier: "We have no bananas," or as a negative response.

Teacher: Do you want another test?

Students: No!

S X mw V/XD  
 Mary doesn't called Mike.

S X mw Vb  
 Mary doesn't call Mike.

S X mw Vb  
 Mary didn't call Mike.

★ Never use V/XO, V/XS or V/XD after an X-Word
